

## **ACAAI Living Named Lecture:**

---

- Purpose:*** Recognize outstanding contributions to the specialty of allergy, asthma, or immunology as well as noteworthy contributions to the ACAAI.
- Criteria:*** Candidates must be an ACAAI Fellow or Member and have made extraordinary and noteworthy contribution (s) to the ACAAI and to the specialty of allergy, asthma or immunology in at least two of the following areas:  
*Education* - considerations include number of publications, preparation of textbooks, lectureships, audio and videotape presentations;  
*Leadership* – considerations include chairmanships of committees, participation on governing boards, local, state and national leadership participation/recognition; and,  
*Clinical practice* – considerations include recognition by peers, academic and/or community practice, noteworthy community service.
- Eligibility:*** Individuals who meet the criteria.
- Selection:*** Any fellow/member or substructure of the College can petition the Board of Regents for a living named lecture. Nominations, in writing and accompanied by proper documentation are to be forwarded to the Past Presidents' Committee for review. The Past Presidents' Committee will forward its recommendations along with applications to the Board of Regents for final approval (See attached application). Approval for the establishment of the lectureship will be by ballot and require two-thirds affirmative vote of the members of the Board of Regents.  
Following approval, speakers for the lectureship will be determined by the Annual Program Committee. The selection criteria for speakers shall be determined separately for each lecture established.
- Award:*** A plaque suitably engraved.
- When given:*** The lecture shall be scheduled for the annual meeting at a time designated by the chair of the Annual Program Committee for two consecutive years.
- Compensation:*** For Honoree: Waiver of the annual meeting registration fee for the two annual meetings at which the lecture is presented, travel, and hotel accommodations of 2 nights, room and tax only.
- History:*** Certain leaders of ACAAI thought that many of the outstanding members of the College were not being sufficiently recognized by their peers. In 1999, a subcommittee of the Board of Regents thought to remedy this oversight through the establishment of living named lectureships.
